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C. YOUR VIEWS ON THE POTENTIAL OPTIONS FOR THE PAVILION

The Parish Council and Village Action Plan carried out a consultation process with the current users of the Pavilion and this identified some possible options. The potential impact on Council Tax is also provided (this assumes some fundraising and grants).

Option 1, "Do Nothing / Closure".

This option is likely to result in the facility being closed within 5 years.

This option would have no impact on Council Tax.

Option 2, "Minimal Maintenance".

This option seeks to preserve the facility for an estimated 5 years.

The Council Tax may need to rise by £5 for a Band D property for 5 years to cover the cost.

Option 3, "Renovate and Refurbish".

This option seeks to extend the life of the Pavilion for a further 5-10 years.

The Council Tax may need to rise by £8 for a Band D property for 5 years to cover the cost.

Option 4, "Build an All New (Like-for-Like) Facility".

This option seeks to create an all-new facility, similar in size to the current building.

The Council Tax may need to rise by £20 for a Band D property for 20 years to cover the cost.

Option 5, "Build an All New (Larger) Facility".

This option seeks to create an all-new larger facility incorporating some chargeable business facilities (e.g. office space or other business use).

The Council Tax may need to rise by £29 for a Band D property for 20 years to cover the cost.

D. YOUR VIEWS ON THE POTENTIAL OPTIONS FOR THE CHILDRENS PLAY AREA

The current Play Area is approximately 20 years old and will definitely need attention in the near future. This could be done simultaneously with, or independently of the Pavilion. Three options have been identified below:

Option 1, "Minimal Maintenance".

This option seeks to maintain the current facility as-is, and is likely to lead to its closure on Health and Safety grounds in the foreseeable future. This option would have no impact on Council Tax.

Option 2, "Renovate and Refurbish".

This approach seeks to extend the life of the Play Park for a further 5-10 years. The Council Tax may need to rise by £5 for a Band D property for 5 years to cover the cost.

Option 3, "Build an All New Play Park".

This approach seeks to demolish the existing Play Area and develop an all new facility. The Council Tax may need to rise by £10 for a Band D property for 5 years to cover the cost.
