Are you interested in becoming a Parish Councillor?

If you would like to help develop, improve and protect your local community for the future, why not join Plumpton Parish Council?

On 2nd May 2019, elections will be held to find Councillors to represent the views of residents within the Plumpton Parish.

To be eligible you must be 18 years of age on the day of election or over; a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or EU citizen and qualify under *one* of the following:

- a) be on the electoral register for the Parish
- b) have owned or rented land in the Parish for 12 months or more
- c) during the 12 months resided in that area or in the case of an existing councillor, resided in the parish or within 3 miles of its boundary.

The council meets once a month (for about 2 hours), with additional short planning meetings when required. It is responsible for managing the Parish Precept (budget), considering local planning applications, maintaining the Village Hall & Playing Field and representing residents' views and interests locally and nationally.
