Appointment of Action in Rural Sussex (“AiRS”)

Thank you for coming to Plumpton and meeting with Reg Stone and myself. We agreed the terms your appointment and the contract was signed today, 18 June 2014 between Plumpton Parish Council and the Sussex Rural Community Council, acting through AiRS.

As you know, the immediate first action is the application for the Locality Grant and we look forward to the assistance of AiRS in this. Until the point at which the grant is received it is understood that AiRS will carry out any work on a daily rate basis. Should the grant be awarded then the payment schedule outlined in the contract will apply. Should the grant not be awarded then AiRS will be paid for the work duly carried out to the point at which the contract is deemed to be terminated.

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group looks forward to working closely with AiRS in delivering a robust and successful Neighbourhood Plan for the parish.
