



TRANSPORT & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES Tuesday 27th November 2018 at 19:30

1. Apologies – None
2. The minutes of meetings held on Wednesday 26th September 2018 were read and approved.
3. Matters arising from previous minutes
 - a. It was noted that the PC had still not received any feedback from ESCC Parking Control.
 - b. Any other matters arising are covered by these minutes
4. Environmental Policies
 - a. It was agreed Plumpton Parish Council should adopt an environmental policy
 - b. Sub-committees (Village Hall and Playing Field) would adopt the PC policy and could add further to it as appropriate to their function.
 - c. Clerk has forwarded examples of Environmental Policies on which the PC could base a policy for Plumpton.
 - d. The PC policy could incorporate metrics for choice of suppliers (i.e. taking note of the suppliers environmental impact). GM agreed to take this forward and create a first draft.
5. Update to Footpath/Walks book
 - a. No feedback as yet received from SDNP on our grant application.
6. Community Speed Watch
 - a. After the request for volunteers in the Parish Magazine, one resident expressed an interest.
 - b. The subsequent mention on Facebook unfortunately did not result in anyone coming forward.
 - c. CJ offered to create a poster for Notice Boards - will include East Chilmington.
 - d. NB confirmed that monitoring can only take place from dawn to dusk.
 - e. If the scheme gets the right support from residents and goes ahead the Parish Council have the budget in 2019 for the necessary equipment.
7. SLR Agenda Items
 - a. Due to key highways officers being unavailable, the SLR meeting was cancelled by ESCC
 - b. NB will suggest the 18th January 2019 to them as a possible date for a meeting.
 - c. It was noted that there are no urgent highways matters known the the PC.
