MINUTES OF LAST MEETING 10TH FEBRUARY 2010 TAKEN AS PRESENTED AND APPROVED.

MATTERS ARISING

NEW RATES- PROPOSED NEW RATES FOR HONEYBEES AND ACTIVITY SCHEME – A MEETING BETWEEN THE TWO GROUPS, CLARE AND TERRY TOOK PLACE 11TH MARCH. IT WAS AGREED TO IMPLEMENT THE INCREASE TO THE ACTIVITY SCHEME IN TWO PARTS IE 50% EACH YEAR FOR THE NEXT TWO YEARS. HONEYBEES TO PAY £10.00 PER SESSION FROM START OF NEXT TERM FOR THE NEXT YEAR.

IT WAS AGREED THIS WOULD BE A GOOD IDEA – ANY SUGGESTIONS WOULD HAVE TO BE “QUICK FIX” AS THE LIFE OF THE PAVILION IS NOT KNOWN – ANY INFO GATHERED MIGHT BE OF HELP IN DECIDING THE TYPE OF ENERGY SOURCE /COST FOR THE NEW PAVILION. TERRY HAD SPOKEN TO RICHARD TAYLOR RE NIGHT STORAGE HEATERS WHICH COULD PROVE MORE ECONOMIC THAN THE HEATERS AT PRESENT USED. TERRY WILL LOOK INTO THIS.
