



Plumpton Parish Council: Highway Safety - Strategy

As a community we should not be complacent with regard to the low accident and injury rate on our roads. Neither should we ignore the fact that there are concerns regarding speeding and parking on our roads.

All road users (motorists, cyclists, pedestrians and horse riders alike) must take care, be aware of their environment and take responsibility for their actions.

Plumpton Parish Council understands the concerns regarding speeding and parking and, working with the Plumpton Village Action Plan Road Safety Team, will:

- Investigate which areas of the village are affected by speeding and road traffic incidents by collecting reliable, verifiable data.
- Investigate and identify traffic blackspots.
- Work with East Sussex County Council Highways Department:
To investigate the feasibility and effectiveness of:
 - reducing speed limits on roads in and around Plumpton
 - introducing traffic calming measures at various locations within the village
 - the introduction of double yellow/white lines within certain areas of the villageversus effective policing.
- Work with Sussex Police to:
 - target drivers exceeding current speed limits
 - target parking issues, particularly at peak times.
