Next Steps?

Step 1 – Interested? We need some basic information from everyone who is interested (see the form overleaf) so when Openreach resume taking registrations they can assess the work involved.

Step 2 – Critical mass. The more of you that get involved, the more vouchers we get, and the more money the government will give to the project. We collate and send everyone's addresses to the Openreach Fibre Community Partnership team. At that point we will only share your address and landline(s) and whether there is a school, charity or business at your address, and there is absolutely no obligation to proceed at this stage.

Step 3 – Quotation. Openreach will give us an indicative cost for the scheme and then a quotation.

Step 4 – Delivery Project. We will get back in touch with you and explain what happens next, maybe even getting Openreach to come to a community meeting if that is felt necessary.
